

CHAPTER 1440

Retail Food Establishments

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 1440 was replaced and renamed by Resolution 50-02 adopted April 11, 2002. Under authority of ORC 3717. 01 through 3717.99, the Summit County Board of Health administers and enforces OAC 3717-1-01 through 3717-1-20 (Food Safety Code) and OAC 901:3-4-01 through 901:3-4-18 (Administrative Rules) pertaining to retail food establishments, mobile retail food establishments, seasonal retail food establishments, and temporary retail food establishments. This responsibility includes plan approval, licensing, inspecting, and all other acts or efforts necessary to assure compliance with the retail food establishment law and rules. The retail food establishments law and rules are published by the Ohio Department of Agriculture, copies of which are available for distribution by the Summit County Board of Health.

There are no sections in Chapter 1440. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
