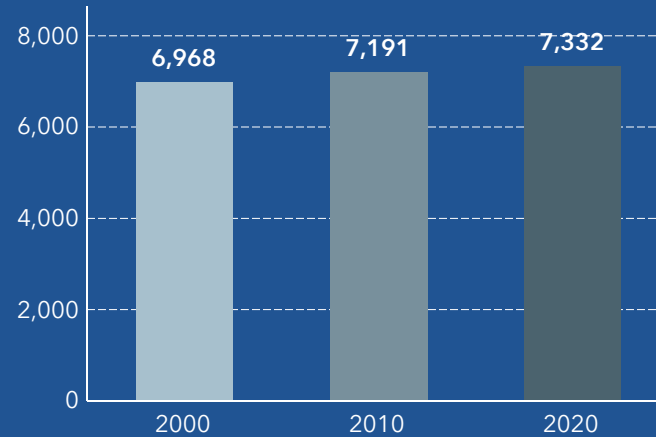

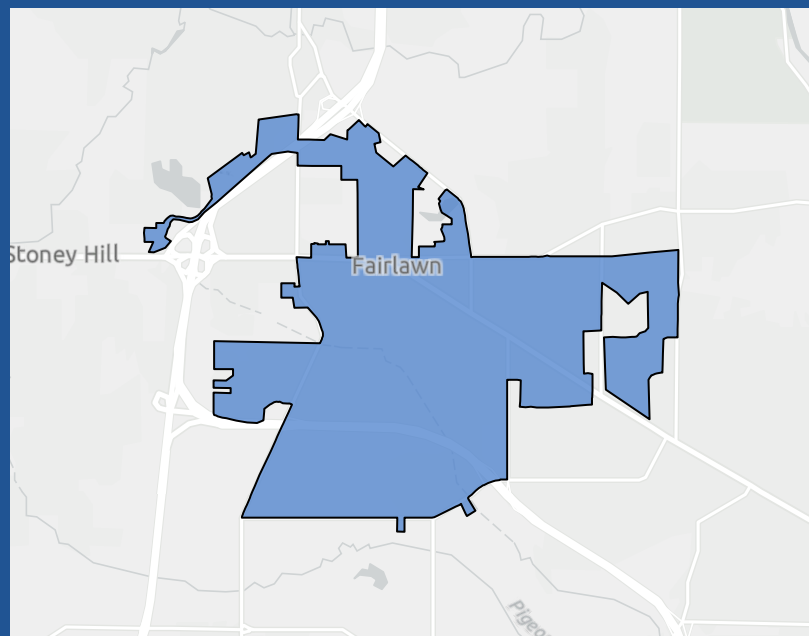

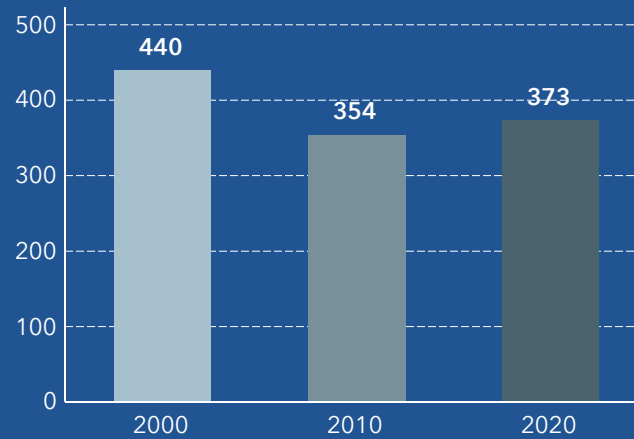
HOUSEHOLD POPULATION

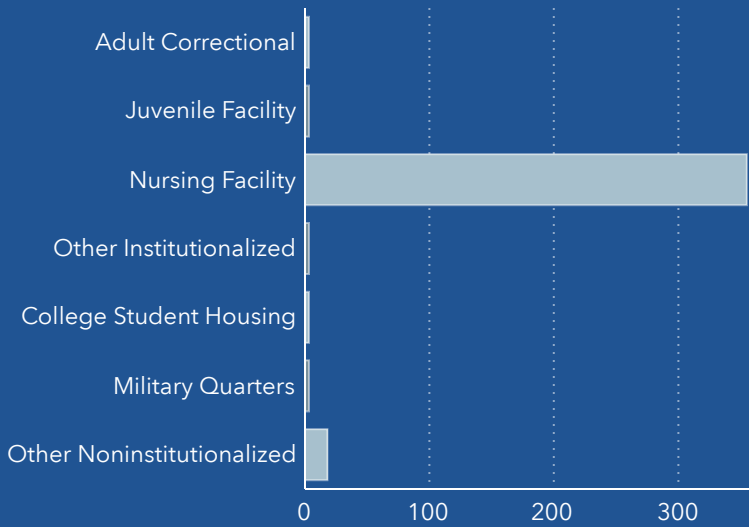
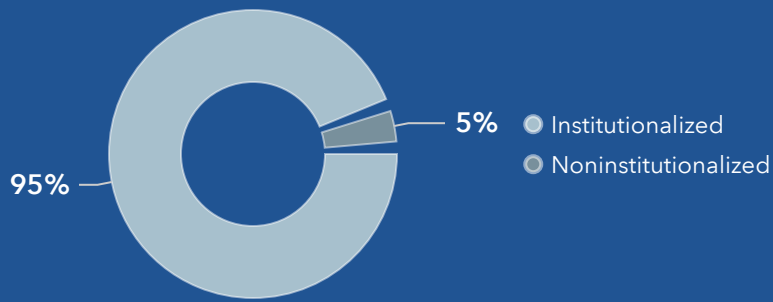
